The BBC Media Action Data Portal has media data from across a number of countries, which provides accurate information on media usage that can be used to help inform people.

Below are some examples questions and how you can use the data portal to find the information that may be interesting for you.

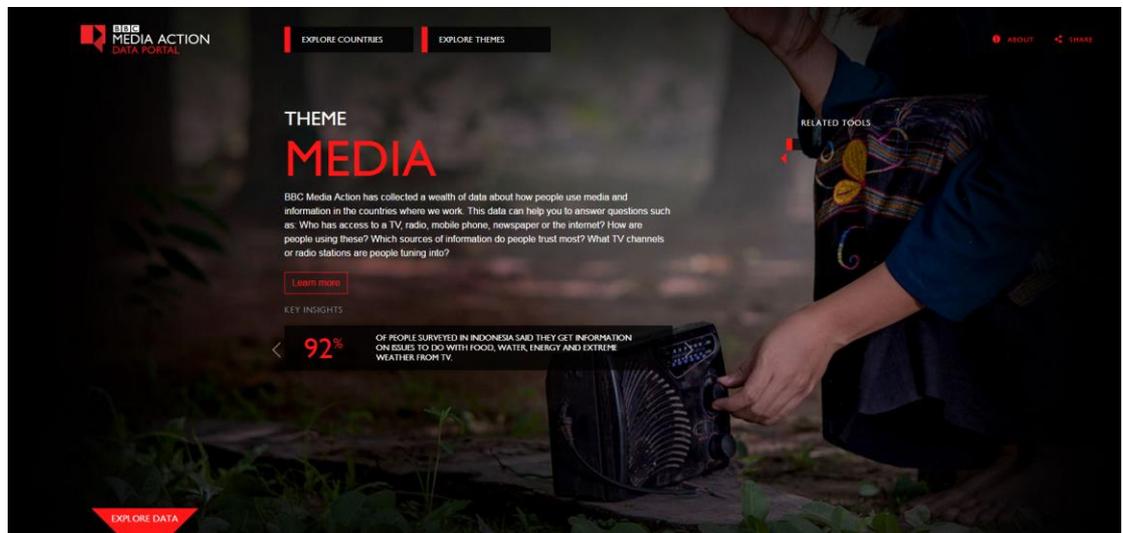
What Media Platform Do People Trust as a Source for Information?

Here are the steps to take to find out how people are using the different media platforms:

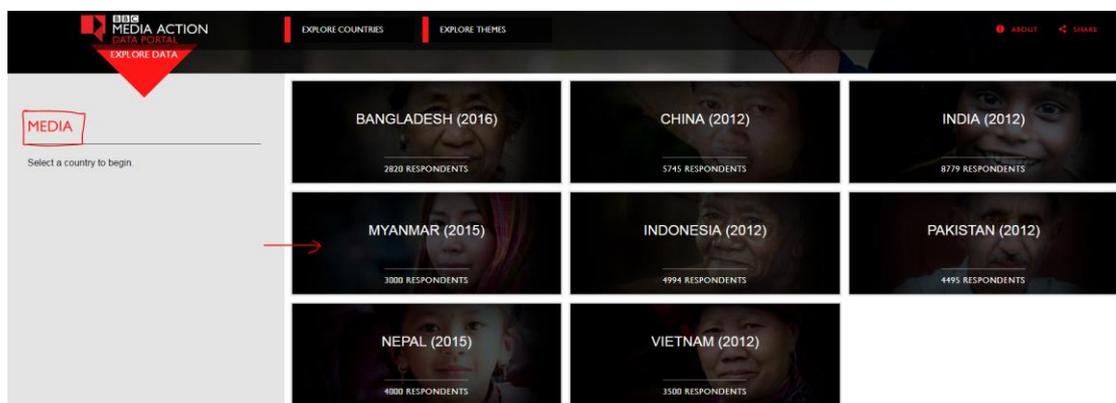
- On the data portal home page, Click on **'Theme'**



- Select '**Media**'

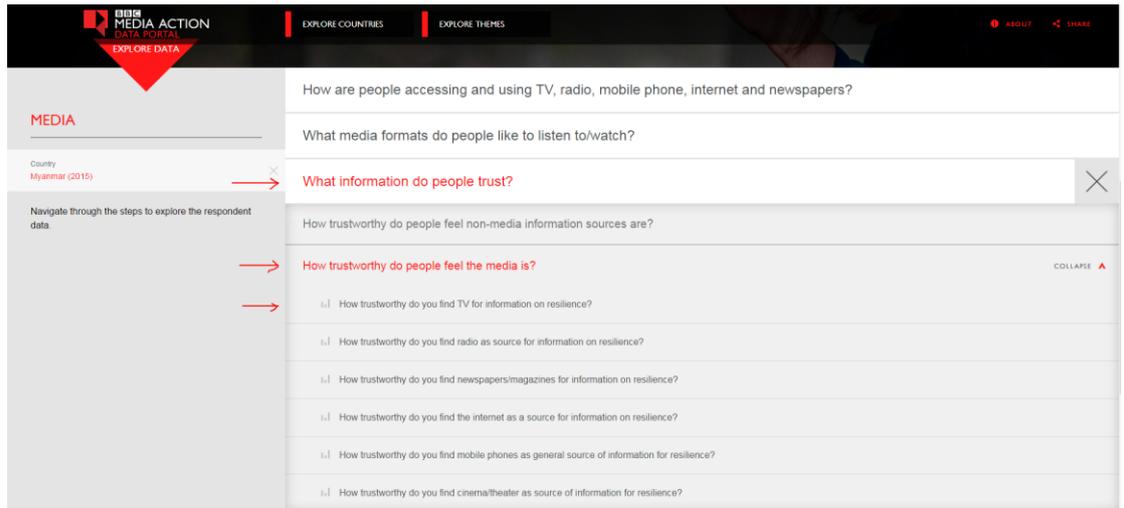


- There are a number of countries with media data. You can view results by country
 - At the left side of the page, click on '**Explore data**'. This will display all the countries available
 - Then select the country you are interested in i.e. '**Myanmar 2015**'



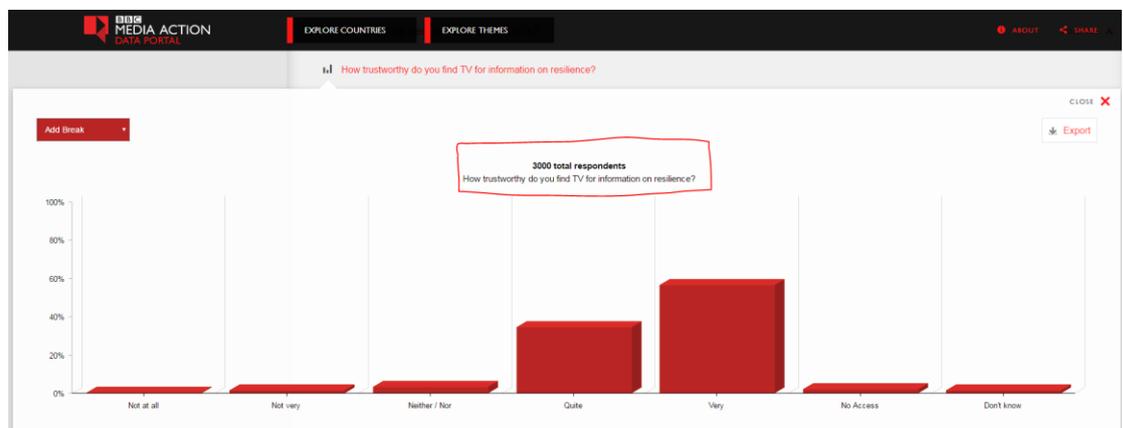
Select the question

- **‘What information do people trust?’** –> you will see a list of sub-questions –> then select –> **‘How trustworthy do people feel the media is?’** within this, are sub-questions – select – **‘How trustworthy do you find TV for information?’**

- On the top left of the chart or graph –> you will see an **‘Add break’** box –> click on the box to display a list of demographics variables that are available i.e. Age, gender, occupation etc.
